

Debris and Trash

Remember as you cut tree limbs and brush to keep the length less than 8 feet and place the limbs in an orderly pile in a place where our workers can access them with the backhoe.

The following is a list of items our public works staff will routinely pick-up from your property:

- **Large Appliances**
- **Large furniture**
- **Bagged leaves and grass**
- **Tree and shrub trimmings**

The Town will not pick up any large quantities of brush due to the cutting of entire trees, nor will brush be picked up that was left by a contractor. Other items will need to be properly disposed of by the property owner/tenant.

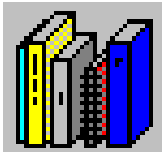


Glasgow Library
