

Help Your Emergency Responders

Emergency personnel responding to a call at your house need your help. Be sure that your house number is clearly visible and readable from the street. Larger numbers of a color that contrasts with your house or reflective numbers placed in a location that are visible from both directions on the road will greatly assist the responders. If you need advice or assistance in placing the numbers please contact your fire department, police department or rescue squad.

Fire Safety

Some helpful fire safety and regulation reminders.

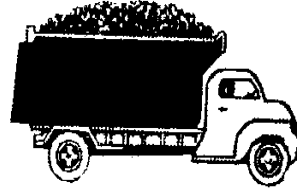
- ✓ Use care when storing fuel and fueling power equipment. Be sure outdoor grills are in appropriate areas.
- ✓ Fireworks are not allowed in the Town
- ✓ Open fires are allowed after 4 p.m. and should be reported to central dispatch before you light it.
- ✓ Remember to test your smoke detectors.
- ✓ Use care when fueling your vehicles.
 - Do not re-enter the vehicle while fueling
 - Do not use cell phones or two way radios
 - Turn off engine
 - Do not smoke



Avoid potential static electricity problems at the gas pump by staying outside your vehicle while refueling.

Enclosed you will find the annual water system community confidence report. This report is prepared annually by the Virginia Department of Health in response to EPA regulations. This report shows no violations for contaminant level during the 2002 calendar year. The violation noted on the last page is for "Failure to Sample". This violation occurred due to a delay in the postal system, making our sample too "old" when it arrived at the lab. We have changed our mailing point to the Buena Vista post office and have had no further problems. Please take the time to review the report and call the Town Office if you have any questions.
