

**Minutes of Special Called Town Council Meeting**  
**June 30, 2014**  
Glasgow Town Hall

Mayor Ruby Ogden Clark called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM.

Acting Town Manager William Rolfe stated the purpose of this meeting was discuss several items with the Glasgow Volunteer Fire Company.

Mr. Rolfe stated the first issue to be discussed was of communication. Mr. Rolfe stated the land line phone at the Fire House has been disconnected and no one can contact anyone in the Fire Company. Mr. Rolfe stated the Fire Chief had to get a new cell phone number and no one had it.

Mr. Rolfe stated the second issue was regarding vendors for the Fire Company calling Town Hall stating their bills are not being paid. President Patrick Stump stated this was his area of responsibility and that he had fallen behind in getting the bills paid in a timely manner due to other issues. Mr. Stump indicated that the bills had been caught up.

The third issue was a discussion on the damage to a fire truck when the Fire Company burned down an old house at the Town's request. Two (2) pumps were damaged that cost approximately \$580 each to repair/replace. The Fire Company does not want to submit a claim to their insurance carrier and requested the Town consider paying for the damage.

Fourth, the Fire Company is trying to purchase another boat for river rescue operations and is requesting the Town consider donating \$6,000 to this purchase. It was noted that the County had some funds remaining at the end of the fiscal year and were also assisting in the purchase of this boat.

Finally, the Fire Company mentioned that they were going to have to replace a tanker truck in the next couple years and the estimated cost is \$450,000.

Mr. Rolfe brought up the advertisement for a new Town Manager and Council indicated they were pleased with things currently and there was no need to move forward rapidly.

Mr. Rolfe stated he had given Mike Bennington authorization to clear the remaining DGIF area at the boat landing since he was down there working for a citizen. The cost was \$1,600.
